The Lord is your shade on your right hand;


The sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night.


The Lord will keep you from all harm – he will watch over your life;

The Lord will watch over your coming and going –



That You will show us again how to love others the way You love us,


That You will put power and courage in our hearts to do your will.




