 and grant us the determination to follow your way. Amen.

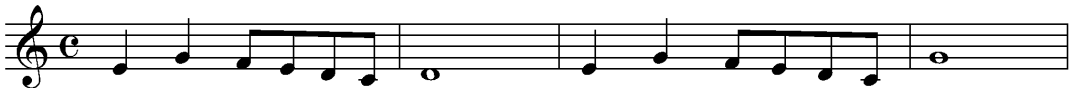
