## Invitation to the Table

### Prayer of Thanksgiving and Remembrance of Saints

The Lord be with you.

**Words of Institution**

**Sharing of the Bread and Cup**

*When sharing communion in the pews, it is appropriate for words to be softly spoken as the elements are passed. If you are comfortable doing so, you might say, "The body of Christ given for you," as you pass the bread to your neighbor. Similarly, you may say, "The blood of Christ shed for you," when passing the cups. Alternatively, "The bread of life, given for you," and "The cup of salvation poured out for you," may be used. The words are less important than a sense of hospitality and community that is shared.*
