## **Bible Exhibit**

On Saturday, May 29th, at 10 am, the Presbyterian Heritage Center in Montreat opens **The Word: History of the English Language Bible**, an exhibit featuring rare 16th and 17th first and early edition Bibles, including the two copies of the first editions of King James Bible (1611 – He and She variations), Geneva (1567), Queen Elizabeth I's The Bishops' Bible (1568), King Henry VIII's The Great Bible (1540) and many more! The exhibit shows translations of well-known verses from the Wyclif (1382) manuscript Bible through modern day printed versions. Several modern Bible translations were worked on here in the Swannanoa Valley.

Come see one of North America's best displays of rare Bibles and learn about their impact on American life over the centuries. Coffee and refreshments will be served at the opening of the exhibit.

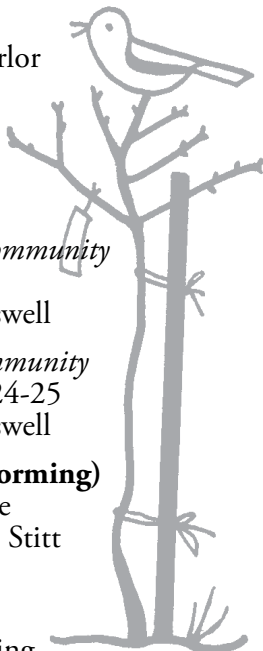

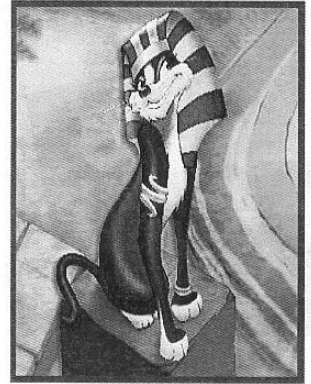

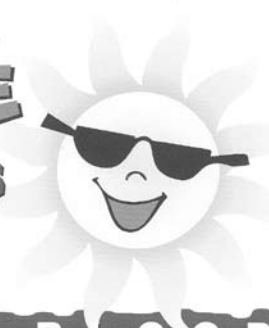
